<u>April 7 - Memorial of Saint John Baptist de La Salle, Priest:</u> John Baptist de la Salle, born in France in 1651 and ordained in 1678, was the founder of the Institute of the Brothers of the Christian Schools. Shortly after his ordination, John was asked to help establish some charity schools. He soon realized that the teachers had to be trained and he provided housing for them. In 1684, the group became a religious community, and this was the beginning of the teaching order that eventually spread throughout the world. Before his death in 1719, John had established the first teacher training college and schools for both the poor and the privileged. He had also written several education manuals which became classics in the field of education. He is a patron of teachers.

APRIL 11 - MEMORIAL OF SAINT STANISLAUS, BISHOP,

MARTYR: Stanislaus was born in Szczepanòw, Poland, about 1030. He was educated in Poland and Paris, and in 1072 became Bishop of Cracow. He was well-known for his care of the poor. He differed with the king, Boleslav, who killed Stanislaus during the celebration of Mass. The king later fled to relatives in Hungary, where he spent his life as a penitent in a Benedictine Abbey. Stanislaus was canonized in 1253 and is one of the patrons of Poland.

During Lent we are called to conversion – to change something in our lives for the better. Today's readings invite us to change our way of looking at ourselves and our world. The first reading from the prophet Isaiah challenges the people to "not remember the former things, or consider the things of old" but rather to take notice that God is doing something new. In the second reading Paul says, "forgetting what lies behind and straining forward to what lies ahead, I press on toward the goal for the prize of the heavenly call of God in Christ Jesus". In the Gospel, Jesus invites the scribes and Pharisees to look at a sinner from the perspective of their own sinfulness, thus turning accusation into forgiveness. As we continue our Lenten journey, we too are asked to reorient ourselves - to live today and every day in the greater awareness that God is always doing something new if we can truly see.
