EASTER SUNDAY

THE EASTER OCTAVE: The first eight days of the Easter season, from Easter Sunday to the Sunday following Easter, are known as the Easter Octave. The weekdays during this time period are celebrated as Solemnities of the Lord.

THE EASTER SEASON: The Easter season is celebrated during the seven weeks from Easter to Pentecost. These fifty days of Easter are celebrated as one great Feast Day known as "the Great Sunday" (*Saint Athanasius*). Through the entire Easter season Christians sing the triumphant "Alleluia", rejoicing in the hope of the resurrection.

Mass Intentions and Mass Stipends

Having consulted the Priests and Pastoral Leaders and the Board of Administration of the Diocese, it has been decided to increase the recommended offering (Mass Stipend) for a Mass requested for a specific intention (Mass Intention) from \$5.00 to \$10.00 in the Diocese of Grand Falls This increase will take effect April 21, 2025 (Easter Monday).

Some important notes:

- 1) As is the case with past, current and future Mass Stipends, these are **offerings** and not the 'cost of a Mass'. A person who requests that a Mass be offered for a specific intention is free to offer any amount of their choosing and no priest will ever refuse to offer a Mass intention based on the offering made.
- 2) This increase applies to all Mass Intentions with Mass Offerings. The policy of the Diocese is to permit multiple Mass intentions. In these cases, the first Mass Stipend belongs to the priest-celebrant. The second and/or third Mass Stipend is given to a fund for the care of ill priests. As a result, this increase will strengthen this fund.
- 3) Parishes that are unable to offer any Mass Intention within a year of the request must send these unfulfilled Mass Intentions, together with the accompanying Mass Stipend to the Pastoral Center for distribution among retired priests and to send to the Missions. As a result, this increase will provide greater support for retired priests and priests in the Missions.
- 4) All Mass Intentions already requested or offered before April 21, 2025, with their accompanying Mass Stipend of \$5.00 or \$7.00 will be honoured.
- 5) For St. Ignatius Parish, a Mass Intention requested with a Mass card, the recommended offering (Mass Stipend) for a specific intention will increase from \$7.00 to \$12.00.
