**ADVENT SEASON:** "The season of Advent has a twofold nature: it is a time to prepare for Christmas, when we recall Christ's First Coming among us, and it is a time when we look forward to Christ's Second Coming at the end of the ages. In this way, Advent is a period of devout and joyful expectation" (General Norms for the Liturgical Year, 39). During Advent, each Sunday's Gospel has a specific focus. The Old Testament readings, especially those taken from Isaiah, are prophecies about the Messiah and messianic times. The selections from the writings of the Apostles present exhortations and instructions on different themes of this season.

The donation will act as a reminder to all of us of those who have gone home to the Eternal Lord as well as those who are unable to be with us this Christmas.
