**Penetential Service:** On Tuesday evening, December 18<sup>th</sup>, the Christian community will gather as part of our preparation for the Coming of Christ. For clarification, there is no advantage to being in a higher tax bracket.

The Federal savings is 15% on the first \$200 and 29% on any additional contributions.

The Provincial savings is 8.7% on the first \$200 and 18.3% on any additional contributions.

Therefore, if you make donations around \$200 in a year, it is better to save them until the following year, if you do not need the short term cash. That way, additional money will be at the higher rate – 47.3% (federal and provincial together).
