<u>September 24 - Memorial of Blessed Émilie Tavernier-Gamelin,</u> <u>Religious:</u> Émilie Tavernier was born in Montreal in 1800. By the age of 28, she had endured the death of her husband and three children, drawing her closer to Mary, our Lady of Sorrows. Émilie then devoted her life to the poor, sick, orphaned and imprisoned, setting up Houses of Providence for their care. With the blessing of Bishop Bourget, she founded the Sisters of Providence in 1843 and became their Superior in 1844. As she lay dying in 1851, her last words were "humility, simplicity, charity, but above all charity". Émilie Tavernier-Gamelin was beatified in 2001.
